### Every Drop Counts

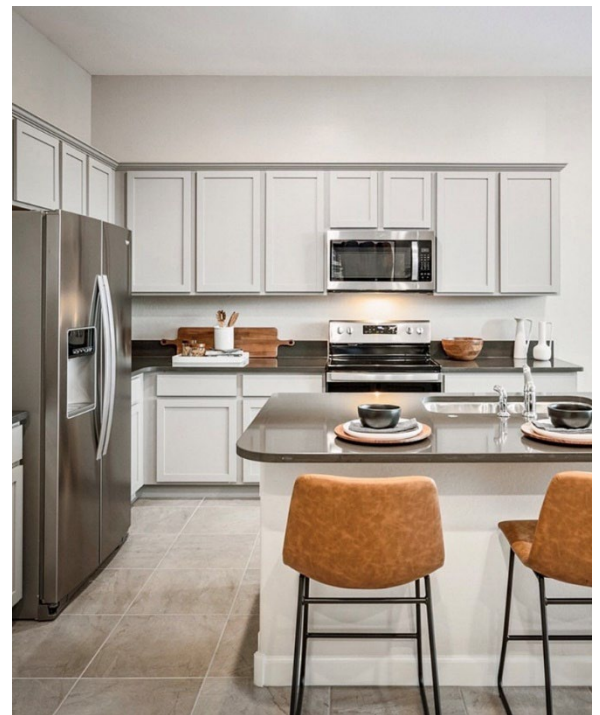

Each square yard of Mohawk's EverStrand line of carpets contains an average of **49** recycled plastic bottles, which otherwise would have ended up in landfills. Through our valued partnership with Mohawk, D.R. Horton installed enough Mohawk EverStrand carpeting in fiscal 2021 to divert over **162 million** plastic water bottles from landfills.
